# BUILDING ASSETS, REDUCING RISKS SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT MODEL TO RECEIVE \$20 MILLION IN INVESTING IN INNOVATION FUNDING FOR EXPANSION

November 10, 2016, Center City, Minn. – <u>Building Assets, Reducing Risks (BARR)</u> will be implemented in at least 116 schools over the next five years as part of a new <u>Investing in Innovation (i3)</u> grant. <u>Spurwink Services, Inc.</u> has been selected as a <u>highest-rated applicant for the i3 competition</u> for FY 2016, which will grant \$20 million in funding for the scale-up of the *BARR* model in schools across the country.

"We are excited and grateful for this i3 Scale-up award. This funding will serve to extend the powerful student achievement and social emotional outcomes demonstrated in our previous i3 Development and Validation grants to more than 146,000 students and 11,600 staff by 2021. BARR's focus on relationships, data, and student strengths continues to transform our schools – rural, suburban and urban – across the country. A remarkable feature of BARR is that ALL students are showing gains with the model, which is testament to the bright future that lies ahead." – Angela Jerabek, Executive Director, BARR Center

The *BARR* model is the *first and only* education program supported by all three categories available through the i3 grant program. Developed in St. Louis Park, Minnesota, BARR launched nationally through a 2010 i3 Development grant, has been further refined through the 2013 Validation grant, and is set to further expand through this i3 Scale-up funding. BARR has consistently demonstrated evidence through rigorous evaluation and strong improvements in academic outcomes, graduation rates, and attendance.





This newly funded i3 project: "Same Students. Same Teachers. Better Results. Scaling up the Validated *BARR* Model", will set the stage for widespread adoption of *BARR* to help improve low performing schools across the United States. Bipartisan support for the project was received from U.S. Senator Angus King (I-ME), U.S. Senator Susan Collins (R-ME), Congresswoman Chellie Pingree (D-ME), U.S. Senator Al Franken (D-MN), U.S. Senator Amy Klobuchar (D-MN), Congressman Keith Ellison (D-MN) and U.S. Senator John Cornyn (R-TX).

*BARR* is a whole-school model for grades 6-12 that provides schools with a comprehensive approach to meeting students' academic, social and emotional needs. The model integrates eight proven strategies to provide a structure that helps educators build safe, strong, trusting relationships with their students — and these connections pave the way for every student to engage in learning. The *BARR* model works with a school's existing curriculum and existing staff, and it can be used to attain any specific school goals. Findings from the *BARR* 2010 i3 development grant study met What Works Clearinghouse Standards without Reservation. Hazelden Publishing provides materials, training, coaching, and outreach services for the BARR Center.
