All the products are made of an alloy with 940/000 silver content that is more valuable than sterling silver. The higher proportion of silver is an indication of both the maximum material worth of the silverware and its greater resistance to tarnishing. The entire collection of silver tableware such as cutlery sets, jugs, vases and bowls, also gifts and mementos for special occasions are meticulously crafted in Vienna. The stunning range of peerless high-end products and luxurious objects are a true pleasure to those who value true exclusivity and enjoy the fine art of living.

This year's exhibition for the ICFF will focus on the dialogue between contemporary objects and the manufactory's iconic masterpieces, designed by the leading artists of the Wiener Werkstätte era and the early 20th century, such as Josef Hoffmann or Otto Prutscher. The contemporary line is represented by the young up-and-coming Austrian designer Julez, further by the well-known New York artist Ted Muehling and by London based Tomás Alonso, winner of the Swarovski Designers of the Future 2015 Miami/Basel Award.
