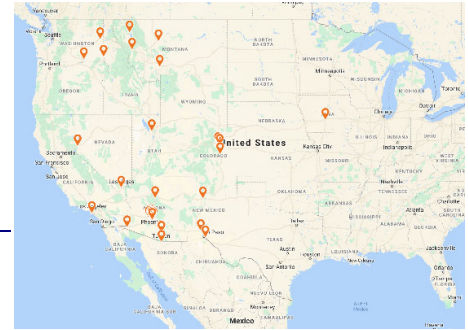

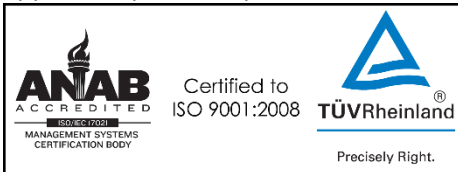

Our Manufacturing facility in Phoenix, AZ is certified to ISO 9001:2008 and houses an A2LA accredited laboratory. Our Albuquerque branch is an IESL approved supplier to Los Alamos National Laboratory, qualified under NQA-1 standards. Our branches and distribution centers all follow quality processes and procedures established to ensure our customers great products and services. We are confident that the quality of product, service, and support we offer is unmatched by our competition. As a distributor of products, we rely heavily on quality relationships with our suppliers, and as a manufacturer, we ensure that product is manufactured and tested according to applicable product specification.
