The only linoleum approved for use on walls, LinoWall opens up a world of coordinated design possibilities. Three pastel colors have been specially chosen to complement the palette of our floor collection, while three more neutral shades provide a direct match between wall and floor. LinoWall comes with our exclusive xf² surface treatment and is Cradle to Cradle Certified[™] Silver.

A Rich Heritage

The Tarkett linoleum plant in Narni, Italy began its production at the end of the 19th century. The plant represents one of the first industries in the region, which shaped the industrial development of Narni and the surrounding area. Tarkett's Lino Collection is made from all-

natural ingredients at the Narni plant, using the same original recipe since 1898. This has enabled Tarkett's team to develop an intimate understanding of every natural ingredient and the expertise to adapt manufacturing to the subtle variations in each year's crop.

The Narni production facility operates on a closed-loop water system and 100% renewable electricity. Tarkett's linoleum material was the first in the industry to earn Cradle to Cradle Certified[™] Silver. All of the raw materials have been assessed by the EPEA and the certifications include:
