sleeping bag? We argue that in temperatures greater than 40F (4.4C), which is most of the summer, you can leave your heavy, space consuming sleeping bag at home and reduce your gear kit weight by at least 1lb. (453g) to 3lbs. (1.36kg.)."

The Escape Pro bivvy includes a 24" (61cm) zipper side opening, a drawstring closure hood to cinch up on colder nights and taped seams to keep moisture out. It measures 31"x 84" (231cm x 78cm). Ideal for multi-day backpack, kayak, or bike-packing trips as a standalone sleep system in the summer or as outer protection and increased warmth for your sleeping bag in fall, winter or spring. Great for use as an emergency shelter on day trips in all four seasons.
