They have offered the "No Print Wonder" Holster to the market for those who wish to carry their pistol with almost zero chance of detection. They achieve this feat using their patent-pending "Cling Tab" system.

The best way to conceal a pistol is to pull the grip in close and nobody does this as well as Clinger Holsters' "No Print Wonder" holster. Their "Cling Tab" system hides your gun better by pulling your pistol grip in tight when you fasten your belt. The "No Print Wonder" holster sits inside the waistband with two belt clips holding the holster on the belt. Their secret to "Deep Concealment" lies in the tabs that connect the belt clips to the holster. The tab that connects the belt clip to the grip side of the holster is stiff while the tab on the other side of the holster is flexible. This allows your belt to pull the grip side of the holster in close to the body while still allowing the holster to flex around your waist.

Their patent-pending "No-Print Wonder" holster sells for just \$59.99 and comes with a Lifetime Warranty. Clinger Holsters currently supports almost 300 gun models so most people will have no trouble finding their favorite gun model listed on Clinger Holsters' list of supported gun models.
