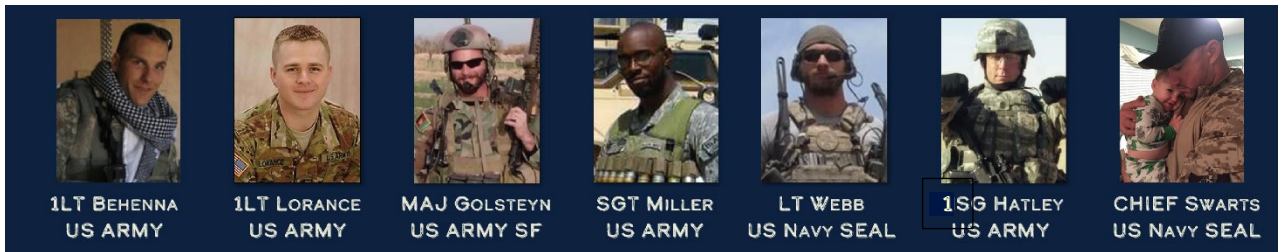

JUSTICE FOR WARRIORS

In 2019, UAP helped Congressmen Gohmert and Hunter establish the "Justice for Warriors Caucus," a group of Congressmen dedicated to addressing areas where the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ) must be enhanced while also weighing in on behalf of each Warrior UAP supports.

What We Do

1. RAISE AWARENESS



From face-to-face interactions with, and presentations produced for, the President, Senators, Congressmen, and their staff; to engaging in interviews with the media; to communicating with the public via direct mail, email, and social media, including [UAP's web site](#), [Facebook](#), Twitter, Instagram, LinkedIn, etc.... ; to sponsoring a NASCAR; UAP leverages all means of communication to enhance understanding and support for our Nation's Warriors and their families, and to help facilitate presidential pardons and Congressional support for clemency, paroles, and other legislative acts which support our Warriors.

2. FUND LEGAL REPRESENTATION



UAP funds legal defense teams (attorneys, investigators, experts, graphic artists, etc...): to preserve our Nation's Warriors' Rights and the "Presumption of Innocence" while defending against Unlawful Command Influence (UCI), prosecutorial misconduct, and abuse by investigators.

3. SUPPORT REINTEGRATION



UAP provides support for transitioning Warriors to assist with reintegration with their family and back into our civilian society. This includes: Counseling, mentorship, networking, training and educating, health care, family court support, military record upgrades, veterans' benefits access, and, if unjustly imprisoned, supporting visitation by loved ones and stipends to help with family and individual needs, e.g., books, stamps, magazines, etc...

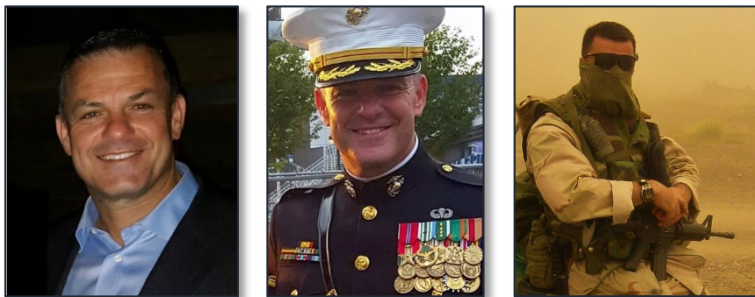
HERBERT WILLIAM "BILL" DONAHUE

In November 2005, Major Herbert William "Bill" Donahue, USMC (Ret.), a highly decorated combat veteran of the Vietnam War, observed six US Marines, accused by our Government of killing Iraqi civilians, being treated like convicted felons, before they were tried. The images of them in hand and leg irons, prior to any finding of guilt, distressed and offended the Major. He decided to do something to ensure those Marines, and others who volunteer to serve in harm's way to protect our US Constitution and American way of life, would receive the best defense, the most pristine of trials and, unquestionably, every Constitutional Right they served to protect.
