M22 Tactical, a veteran owned and operated business, is showcasing the REDCAT Dry Fire Trainer; a small, simple device that enables realistic dry-fire training on the AR Platform at a fraction of the cost of similar products on the market.

### DETAILS ABOUT THE REDCAT

The REDCAT is a small plastic device about the size of a AA battery (3 in long, ½ in wide and ¾ in tall) that fits snugly inside an AR lower receiver. Installation takes less than 10 seconds: pop the takedown pin, drop in the REDCAT and close it back up. Once installed, the REDCAT allows the safety to engage and disengage at any time for dry fire training. Additionally, the action remains fully functional allowing an operator to incorporate dummy rounds into a dry fire session to closely simulate live fire.

The REDCAT offers simple, low-cost, Critical Associative Training (CAT) for the operator. Finally! Real-world dry fire training on the AR platform! The REDCAT is inexpensive--and it *changes the game*.

### HOW THE REDCAT CAME TO BE

In 2018, the NSSF estimated there were between 5-10 million AR-15 style rifles in circulation within the military, law enforcement and civilian communities. Today, civilians alone own well over 10 million ARs for many reasons including hunting, competition and home-defense.

Proficiency is vital to the military, law enforcement, competitors, hunters, and home defenders. Consistent, repetitive training ensures safety, accuracy and speed. Effective and repetitive training off range, without live ammo increases familiarity and proficiency. Dry fire training, including repeated operation of the controls, is essential to develop muscle memory.

On the AR platform the trigger and the sear are one solid piece. This is a good design for field conditions making the rifle nearly impossible to fire with the safety engaged. Unfortunately, this design makes dry fire practice difficult because the operator must rack the bolt to free the safety selector after pulling the trigger. The REDCAT solves this issue!
