



Ballistic Barrier Products (BBP) has a line of bullet-resistant window shades, door covers, and hallway barricades meant to protect against handgun attacks that would be associated with active shooter events in public buildings, drive-bys, or home invasions. The products are made from a custom weave of Kevlar® para-aramid fiber, the same type of fiber used in the anti-ballistic body armor used by military and law enforcement, which is light and flexible, allowing protection to be placed in areas where conventional solutions made from glass, fiberglass, plastic, or steel are not practical to deploy due to weight or installation complications. The product can also be made into temporary curtains, tents, enclosures, or blast debris protection barricades. All products are certified to either UL 752 Level 3 (up to .44 Magnum) or Level 2 (up to .357 Magnum) protection. These options cover a wide range of the typical handguns and ammunition used in most threats (9mm, .38 Special, .45 ACP, and 10mm). The products are intended for any commercial, industrial, or residential application that would benefit from such protection.

One unique aspect of the product line is how easy it is to install. Due to their size and weight, the installation of traditional bullet-resistant materials can turn into major construction projects for not just the door or window but also to add reinforcement to the surrounding frame and walls. Often this also requires permits and engineering sign-off as well. BBP products are lightweight and easy to install, designed so that a homeowner can do it without any professional assistance, and usually be completed in less than 30 minutes.

The barriers can be both fixed-in-place (static coverings that mount directly to the door surface) or roll up like a conventional window shade, to be out of the way when not in use. Since the material behaves much like a traditional window shade or curtain, using it over a window also allows it to remain an exit egress, which bullet-resistant glass does not permit. The size and appearance are both completely customizable, so it can be colored, have print patterns applied to it, or shaped to match the décor of any room. For extreme applications, the fabrics can be made up to 102" in one direction and virtually no limit in the other.

BBP leverages over 17 years of experience developing body armor for law enforcement and the military to apply the same rigorous test methodologies and process discipline to its products. All products have been certified to UL752 standards by Underwriters Laboratory (UL) and are UL Listed to ensure consistent protection from violent attacks using handguns. The products are made in the USA and are Berry Amendment compliant.
