The Taylor Foundation Makes SHOT Show Debut, Bringing PTSD Support to the Front Line

Las Vegas, NV — [DATE] — [The Taylor Foundation](#) (TTF), a nonprofit dedicated to supporting law enforcement, military, first responders, and their families living with PTSD, will make its **first-ever appearance at SHOT Show in 2026—bringing mental health directly into one of the most influential spaces in public safety.**

Founded in 2022 by musician **Corey Taylor** (Slipknot, Stone Sour, CMFT), The Taylor Foundation amplifies innovative, community-based mental health resources across the U.S. and Canada. Rather than creating programs in isolation, TTF fuels organizations already doing life-saving work for those who serve.

At SHOT Show, TTF's booth will offer a rare, hands-on experience: attendees can anonymously share their PTSD stories, honor fallen brothers and sisters, and connect with mental health resources built specifically for law enforcement.

A **special meet-and-greet appearance** by Corey Taylor and **Alicia Taylor** (The Cherry Bombs, former Atlanta Falcons Cheerleader) is planned during the show (*day/time to be announced*).

“This isn’t about awareness,” said Mary Mosteller, Managing Director of TTF. “It’s about survival. Mental health is officer safety.”
