

Nearly one-third of high school students are student-athletes






















JUST A FEW OF OUR INNOVATIVE LEARNING EXPERIENCES

- S.T.A.T. is transforming instruction through personalized, 1:1 learning that meets individual student needs.
- Students begin learning Spanish in Grade 4 at 45 schools through the Passport Program.
- All full-day PreK programs were accredited by the Maryland State Department of Education for quality.
- The Elementary STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) Fair encourages team project development among our young learners.
- The Mobile Innovation Lab brings cutting-edge makerspace technologies to schools for hands-on learning.
- Magnet programs provide unique immersion opportunities, like the Early College Program @ Woodlawn High School and the middle school magnet program at the Northwest Academy of Health Sciences.
- Students conduct yearlong independent research and present their results to the community at the annual High School Research Symposium.
- Half of students begin job training during high school through Career and Technology Education including cybersecurity, virtual reality, teacher preparation, and many other fields.
- Through the Chinese Cultural Exchange Program, BCPS families host a student from Xi'an Tie Yi High School during winter, and then send BCPS students to live with Chinese families, attend school, and tour Xi'an during spring.
- Partnerships with the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra, the Walters Art Museum, and the Baltimore Museum of Art elevate student training opportunities in the arts.
